Welcome to the story of the Civil War, told in a setting that amazes and inspires. "A New Birth of Freedom" immerses you in the sight, sounds and emotions of the battle and its aftermath in preparation for your expertly narrated guided tour of the battlefields. Climb aboard the shuttle that transports you to the Eisenhower National Historic Site, home of the 34th president, Dwight D. Eisenhower and his wife Mamie. Travel a short distance to the "Sweetest Place of Earth" and ride the tram through a simulated chocolate factory; then cruise through time at the world class AACA Museum.

Day 1 Depart Crossgate Mall and travel to Gettysburg PA. Upon arrival, visit the **Gettysburg Museum and Visitor Center**, and see the film "A New Birth of Freedom" View the **Cyclorama painting**, then depart for your lodging for the next two nights. Dinner this evening will be at a local restaurant in historic Gettysburg.

Day 2 After a delicious breakfast, depart for a day in Gettysburg. Meet our guide for a **narrated tour** aboard our coach. The guide will outline the history of the famous battle as you wind your way through the battlefield,. (lunch on you own in the area). After lunch board the shuttle which transport you to the **Eisenhower National Historic Site**, the 230 acre farm which was the only home ever owned by President Dwight D. Eisenhower and his wife, Mamie. After returning to the park via the shuttle, board our coach and depart for dinner at one of the popular local restaurants.

Day 3 Enjoy breakfast check out of the hotel and depart for Hershey. Arrive at the **AACA Museum** for a world-class automotive experience! You'll find the largest number of buses under one roof in the country, along with a display of more than 20 motorcycles, Cushman and scooters. See an authentic Valentine diner, along with a gas station from the 1940's and 1900's auto machine shop. After your-visit, continue to the nearby **Hershey's Chocolate World Visitors Center** where you will board the tram to begin an informative and fun ride through a simulated chocolate factory which will end with a free sample. Spend time shopping for chocolate delights in the shop. Lunch is on your own in the food court, followed by departure home with a wonderful memories of your vacation in historic Gettysburg & Hershey, PA.

Some language, gestures and suggestive art on apparel may be considered inappropriate. HERSHEY PARK reserves the right to address these issues with all guests. Your cooperation is appreciated.

LOCKERS/CHANGING ROOMS Lockers are available inside the Park Main Entrance, at Carrousel Circle, various restrooms, by ROLLER SOAKER, Pioneer Frontier changing area, outside the Park near the restrooms in the west parking lot, near The Dad's Pet Care Barking Lot, and on the walkway near Hershey Museum. A nominal fee is charged depending on the size. **Changing rooms** are available near TIDAL FORCE and ROLLER SOAKER

STROLLERS Bring your own or rent one of our strollers. Strollers are available (for a rental fee) inside the Main Entrance on a first-come-first-serve basis.
