Sample mouth-watering, sweet confections at Dorothy Cox Chocolates. Explore the exhibits of "all things kitchen" at the Culinary Arts Museum. Savor sparkling wines at Westport Rivers Winery. Tour historic Providence and Roger Williams Park and discover a true "taste" of beautiful New England.

Day 1—Depart Albany Crossgates Mall and head for Providence, RI. First stop will be at the **Culinary Arts Museum at Johnson & Wales University**. This premier museums devoted to preservation of the history of the culinary and hospitality industries. Kitchen gadgets, a dinner museum, culinary show-pieces, a stove museum, and a pantheon of chefs are among the items you will explore. Our accommodations will be in beautiful Providence, RI. Check-in and relax before we depart for dinner.

Day 2—Enjoy breakfast at our hotel this morning before we meet our tour guide for a guided tour of the historic capital city of Providence, RI. You will **view Waterplace Park, Roger Williams Park & National Memorial, and the First Baptist Church**. This is the oldest Baptist Church in the Americas, founded by Roger Williams in 1638. Later, you will depart for Fairhaven, MA to visit **Dorothy Cox Chocolates**. Here, you will enjoy chocolate samples and demonstrations. The Cox family has owned and operated the company since 1928. A wine tasting will be included at **Westport Rivers Winery** in Westport, MA. This family owned vineyard is best known for its sparkling wines, which are well-renown world wide. This evening you will enjoy dinner and a unique chef demonstration at Gepetto's on Federal Hill.

Day 3—Breakfast at the hotel, check out and depart for Guilford, CT. Visit **Bishop's Orchards**, this family run orchard is known for its "big red apple" landmark. Take some produce along with you for the ride home.

While in our water ride area (ROLLER SOAKER, Straight Shooters, Winding Rivers, Canyon River Rapids, and TIDAL FORCE), swimsuits may be worn, but after completion of these rides, we ask that you change to more appropriate attire (i.e. shorts, shirt, footwear) prior to leaving this area. Some language, gestures and suggestive art on apparel may be considered inappropriate. HERSHEY PARK reserves the right to address these issues with all guests. Your cooperation is appreciated.

LOCKERS/CHANGING ROOMS Lockers are available inside the Park Main Entrance, at Carrousel Circle, various restrooms, by ROLLER SOAKER, Pioneer Frontier changing area, outside the Park near the restrooms in the west parking lot, near The Dad's Pet Care Barking Lot, and on the walkway near Hershey Museum. A nominal fee is charged depending on the size. **Changing rooms** are available near TIDAL FORCE and ROLLER SOAKER

STROLLERS Bring your own or rent one of our strollers. Strollers are available (for a rental fee) inside the Main Entrance on a first-come-first-serve basis.
