They rented land to tenant farmers of diverse European backgrounds and relied on a community of 2 enslave Africans to operate the complex. Farming and milling still goes on at Philipsburg today. Hear the Manor's history from the perspective of those who toiled there. We will then have lunch at Sunset Cove for lunch and then on to The Great Jack O'Lantern Blaze where you can immerse yourself in more than 3,000 awe-inspiring hand carved pumpkins which are hanging from trees running along the ground in endless rows, and rising in the sky stacked up as incredible totem poles, the hand-carved pumpkins will fill Van Cortlandt's rolling landscape in themed areas such as the ghostly graveyard, outer space, circus arena, the aquarium and more.
