A National Historic Landmark, the Intrepid Sea-Air-Space Museum is making it's return to Pier 86, Join us for the grand re-opening celebration after it's 18-month renovation. The Intrepid houses a large collection of aircraft including a British Royal Navy "submarine Scimitar", Navy F-14 Tomcat, an Air Force F-16 Fighting Falcon, an A-12 Blackbird spy plane and a Polish MiG-21. The helicopter collection includes two Vietnam-era UH-1 Hueys and a fully restored Army AH-1 Cobra. There will be time on your own in the Times Square area after the museum. We will depart at 6:00 pm from Bryant Park.
